Speaker: Prof. **Stephany Griffith-Jones** is Emeritus Professor at Institute of Development Studies, Sussex University. She also serves as Financial Markets Director of the Initiative for Policy Dialogue at Columbia University.

Prof. **Stephany Griffith-Jones** is a distinguished economist researching and providing policy advice on reforming the international and national financial architecture, with emphasis on the domestic financial sector from a development perspective and on macro-economic management of capital flows in emerging and low income countries. She is leading many major international research projects on international financial and macro-economic issues, with networks of senior academics and policy-makers from developed and developing countries. She has published widely, having written or edited over twenty books and numerous journal and newspaper articles. She acted as advisor for many international organizations, including the European Commission, European Parliament, World Bank, Commonwealth Secretariat, IADB, AfDB, and various UN agencies and several governments and Central Banks, including the UK, Chilean, Swedish, South African, Tanzanian, Brazilian and Czech.
